

WHAT DO ADULLAM STUDENTS DO?

Another name for the Adullam program is the Wilberforce Force.

Adullam refers to a Vision and Ministry Training Program for students from different backgrounds. This document focuses on College students.

1. We encourage the students in this program to go deep in the Scriptures with applications (Tools such as a Chronological Bible Reading Plan for the first year or McCheynne Bible Reading Plan). This could take 2 years to complete.
2. We hope to inspire individuals who begin ministering to others with support from the Adullam Leadership team and the local church.
3. Book Studies (For Example the following - Dangers of a Shallow Faith by A.W Tozer, The Church in Babylon by Erwin Lutzer, Why Do I Exist? By Amos Tarfa, Amazing Grace by Eric Metaxas, And other Apologetics tools such as Can Science Explain Everything by John Lennox, Against the Flow by Lennox and Joseph by John Lennox)
4. **Friday Evening Dinners and Discussions - 5:30-7:30pm.** Dinner from 5:30-6pm, 6pm-6:45pm Teaching, 6:45pm-7:30pm - Questions and Answers, Testimonies, Singing and Prayer). Students are welcome to stay in the venue till 8:30. We encourage students to make time to be productive with their school work so they can attend the Friday evening opportunity. They should also be seeking opportunities to be involved in their local fellowship.
5. The Friday Evening Discussions will have teachings from the Bible from Amos Tarfa, Guest Speakers from the Fellowship of Christian Professionals and other people in the faith from the community and beyond. Opportunities for singing hymns or songs on peoples hearts will be available too.
6. We hope to see leaders raised and Disciples Made.
7. Materials from The Apologetics Institute Program is also available to the students.
8. Online videos for them to watch during the week (Maybe 2 - 15 minute videos).
9. Seek out service opportunities where students serve in the community and show the love of Christ.
10. We want to encourage students to finish the New Testament Annually and do a Study of some of Old Testament books. Basically they can register for a few courses on the Adullam Platform which allows them to learn and grow. (For example, someone can be registered in the John Course or the 1st Peter Course).

College Adullam Ministry (Wilberforce Force)

This is for students who are in college but want to have a strong foundation in God's Word
